



## About the Board

The Pennsylvania Intergovernmental Risk Management Association (PIRMA), of which your entity is a member, is governed by a Board of Directors. There is an open Board Member position with a term that expires on December 31, 2027.




To qualify to serve as a Director, a nominee must be:

- An elected or appointed representative of the governing body of a PIRMA member, which may include managers or secretaries; or
- An existing full-time employee (persons in the employment of a PIRMA member working not less than an average of thirty (30) hours per week determined on an annual basis) appointed by the governing body of a PIRMA member to represent PIRMA.

There are typically four Board Meetings per year (two in-person, two virtual). Board meetings are one or two days in duration and may require an overnight stay. Board Meeting expenses are paid by PIRMA.

## Submit a Nomination

If you are interested in being considered for the board vacancy, please submit a nomination letter authorized by your governmental entity's governing board along with a short (one hundred words or less) biography indicating your background, qualifications, and your governmental entity's participation in PIRMA. Nominations must be received no later than **July 31, 2024**. Please send nominations to:
